





** Effective May 1, 1998, the Office of Sponsored Projects will exclude non-competing continuation proposals ("continuations") from "proposals" figures, excepting continuation proposals that are negotiated during the life of each award rather than during new proposal negotiations. Also, new and competing continuation proposals will be entered using total period proposed amounts, as opposed to first-period amounts used in previous years (through Fiscal Year 1996-97).
